ANNUAL REPORT 2020-2021

In order to provide higher education to the city of Udumalaipettai, where the greater poet Udumalai Narayanakavi was born, with the zealous efforts of the former minister Hon. L.K. Sadiq Batcha and the selflessness of those who were generous, this college was started with the name "Government College for Men, Udumalaipettai" on 19.08.1971 with 345 new students at Sakthi Co-operative Industrial Estate, Udumalaipettai.

Renamed as "Government Arts College, Udumalaipettai" in September 1992-93, this is one of the premier institutions among grade - I government colleges in Tamil Nadu today with 13 departments and full – time research programmes in the 49th year.

This seat of learning was graded "A" by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council during the academic year 2014-15. The college has also been ranked 71st at the national level and 5th among rural colleges in the National Rankings (NIRF 2018) by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India.

SCHOLARSHIP

An amount of Rs.18, 47,314 has been awarded to 1027 students belonging to the Backward and Most Backward categories this academic year. Scholarships worth Rs.28, 76,665 were disbursed to 583 students in the underprivileged and Scheduled Tribe sections. About 342 students studying through Tamil Medium have been disbursed a lump sum of Rs.3, 07,800.

COMPUTER LITERACY PROGRAMME (CLP)

Considering that computer literacy is the need of the hour, 640 were educated under the Computer Literacy Programme (CLP) developed by the Government of Tamil Nadu for students who do not study Computer Science as a subject in their curriculum.

RESULT

Continuing the service of higher education with 122 professors, the college has graduated 99 per cent of Undergraduate and 99 per cent of Post-graduate students in the academic year 2019-2020.

UNIVERSITY RANK HOLDERS

Laurels have been brought by 14 of our students to the institution by securing positions in the university ranking in the Coimbatore Bharathiar University examinations held in the academic year 2019-2020.

Ms. M. Geetha from B.Sc. Statistics secured the first place at the University level and won a Gold Medal and P. Tamilarasi secured the second place with Silver Medal from the same course. Ms. R. Kalaivani from B. Com. (E.Com) secured the third place, Mr. G. Manikandan from B. Sc. Botany secured the sixth place and Mr. Elenchezhian from B.A. Tamil secured the eighth place. Ms. S. Vaneeswari and Ms. A. Kalaiyarasi from B.Sc. Botany secured ninth and tenth places respectively.

Mr. D. Vijikumar from M.A. Tourism, Ms. J. Jansi Rani from M.Sc. Statistics and Mr. A. Mohamathu Ghouse from M.Sc. Chemistry secured the first place at the university level and won Gold Medals. Ms. K. Sangeetha and Ms. N. Periyanayakam from M.Sc. Chemistry secured the

second place with Silver Medal and the eighth place respectively. Ms. T. Sowdhamani from M.Sc. Computer Science secured fourth place and Ms. M. Sivaranjini from M.Sc. Physics secured eighth place in the university examinations.

COLLEGE GENERAL LIBRARY

The college general library maintains a total collection of 39, 350 books for the use of both students and teachers during the academic year 2020-2021.
